Nomination Criteria**

- Organization should exhibit the values, ethics and principles of the National Association of Social Work
- Organization should demonstrate a significant impact on the community in eliminating or reducing poverty, discrimination and/or oppression, increasing social and economic justice and improving the well-being of client systems
- Organization should demonstrate compassion in its practice with client systems
- Organization should develop and promote exemplary program models with the goal of facilitating quality programs and service delivery to diverse client systems
- Organization should be a change agent and engage in advocacy with and on behalf of client systems
- Organization should employ BSW and MSW trained social workers
- Organization should play a role in training future social workers
- Organization should have been in the business of serving clients in Delaware for at least 10 years

Nomination for the Delaware Social Work Organization of the Year should incorporate as many of the above criteria as possible.
